This year we are offering a virtual 5K to help raise funds for the Environmental Studies Center since we all can't be together safely right now.

How to do a VIRTUAL 5K:

You can complete your 5K (3.1 miles) anytime between Saturday, 10/17 through Sunday, 10/25.

You can complete it anywhere you'd like – on a treadmill, in your neighborhood, on a trail, etc.

You can complete it however you'd like – you can walk, jog, run, heck – you can even swim it if you'd like!

You can complete it by yourself or with friends or family – although we ask that you social distance if you are out with others.

After you complete your 5K:

We would love for you to post comments or pics of you doing your 5K on our FB page! You can wear your 5K shirt or your costumes since we're keeping our spooky theme for Halloween.

Registration:

(All registration is non-refundable)

Youth 17 & Under \$15

Register for the event by choosing the "Sleep-In" option and pick your t-shirt size. Each morning of the virtual event you can stay snuggled in bed knowing you have contributed and you will also get a t-shirt! Shirt/Packet – Mail or Pick Up:

You have the option to either pick up your packet or, for an additional fee of \$5 per registration, you can choose to have your shirt/packet mailed to the address you use on your registration.

Packet Pick Up will be held outside at the Environmental Studies Center on Friday, October 16th from 4PM-7PM. Pick up will be socially distanced and safety precautions will be followed.
