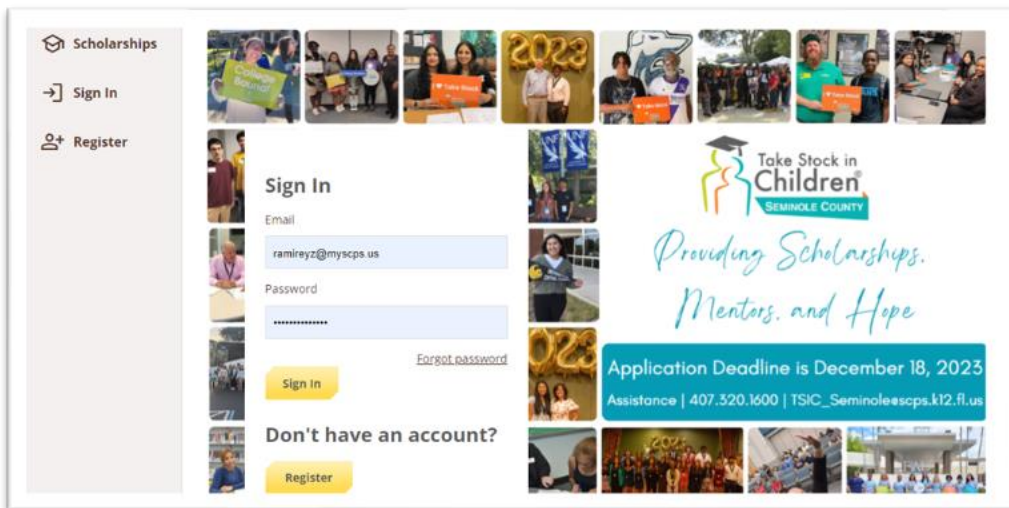


Take Stock In Children – Seminole Application Guide: Applying for the Program and Navigating AwardSpring

The purpose of this guide is to walk you through the process of applying to be a part of the Take Stock In Children – Seminole program using the AwardSpring platform.

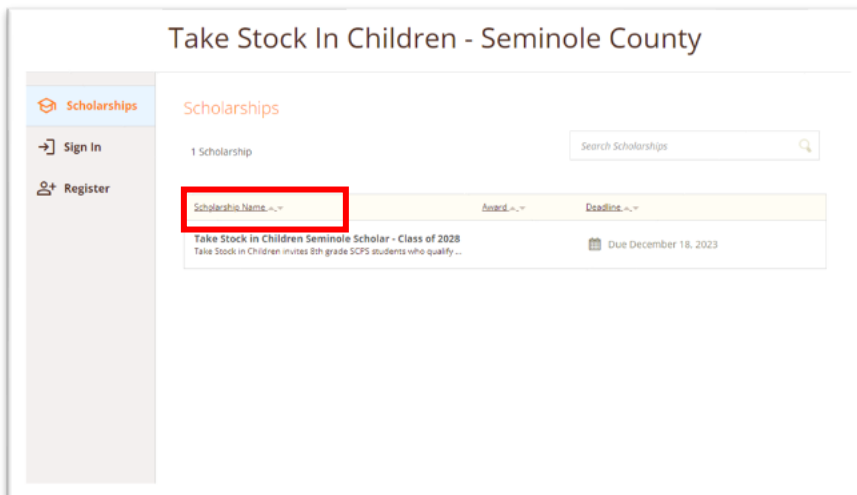
Start by navigating to the Take Stock in Children – Seminole’s AwardSpring site - tsicseminole.awardspring.com.

You will land at the login page.



In the left menu bar, Scholarships is a clickable button. Click the scholarship to see additional information.

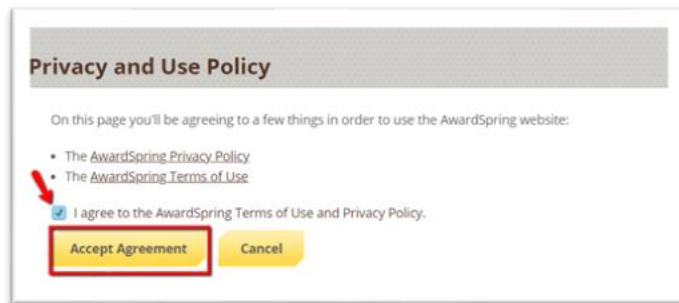
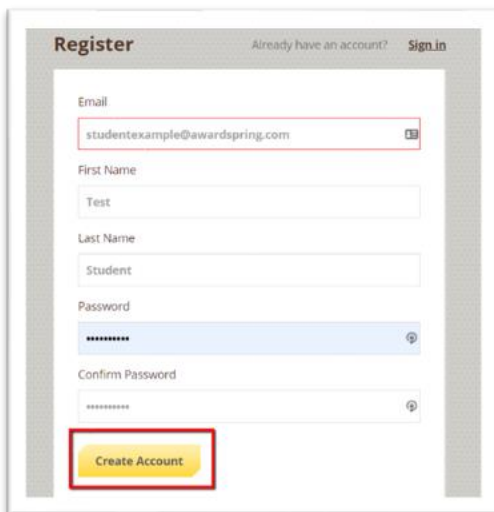

TO LOG IN:

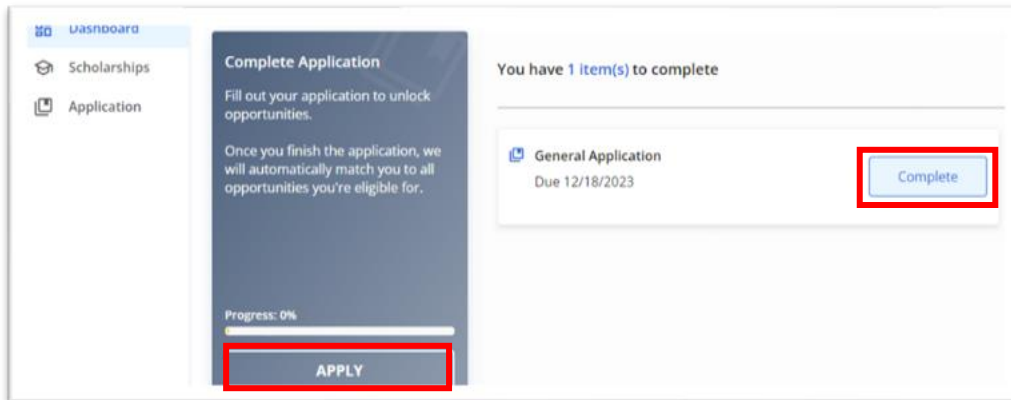
Sign In: If you already have an account. Enter your email address and password and click the yellow Sign In button.

Register: You do not have an account. You will be directed to the registration page. Enter all the required information, click the agreement box, and click the Create Account button.



After login/registration, you will be directed to your Dashboard. You can view information about your application status and additional instructions will be displayed for you here.

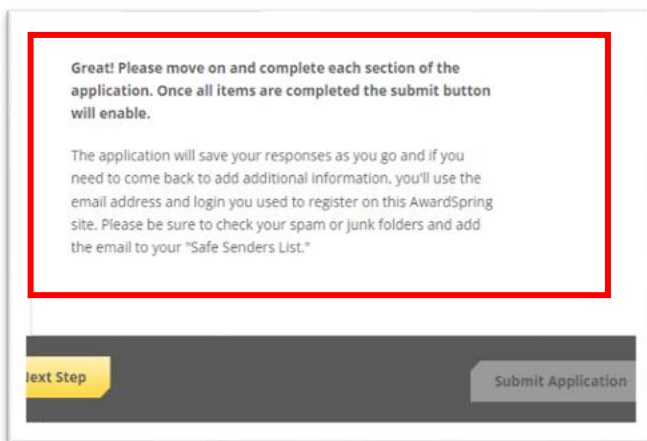
Click the **Apply** or **Complete** button to begin filling out your application.



Complete the initial Program Eligibility section to see if you're eligible for the program.


- Must currently be in the 8th grade enrolled at a SCPS Middle School (Greenwood Lakes, Indian Trails, Jackson Heights, Lawton Chiles, Markham Woods, Millennium, Milwee, Rock Lake, Sanford, South Seminole Academy, Teague, Tuskawilla, or Seminole County Virtual School).
- Must plan to enroll in a SCPS High School during 9th grade (Crooms Academy, Hagerty, Lake Brantley, Lake Howell, Lake Mary, Lyman, Oviedo, Seminole, Winter Springs, or Seminole County Virtual School).
- Must be a U.S. Citizen or Legal Resident and can provide required documentation to prove citizenship or legal resident status.
- Must meet the income eligibility of the Free and Reduced Lunch Program as outlined by the USDA Guideline and can provide required documentation of income eligibility. The 2023-2024 Income Eligibility is detailed in the application as well as at foundationscps.org/Apply-TSIC/

If eligible you will be prompted to continue filling out your application.



If you are not eligible, do not continue filling out the application. Only eligible applicants will be considered for the program. We encourage to check back on the [Foundation's website](#) your senior year for additional scholarship opportunities.

To complete the application, you will need to complete each of seven tabs to submit your application. The application will save your responses as you go and if you need to come back to add additional information. You'll use the email address and login you used to register on this AwardSpring site. Please be sure to check your spam or junk folders and add the email to your "Safe Senders List."
